Who we are and what we do

What data we collect

When you choose to contact us, either directly through contact details provided or through our 'contact us' web form, we request contact information from you:

Address

Contact phone number

Email address

RJC only collects information which we require to carry out our business services. It does not have any email subscription newsletters at the time of writing this policy and do not knowingly use cookies to improve website experience.

The legal basis for us collecting your data is carried out under 'legitimate interest', defined in the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR). Holding and processing your data under legitimate interest means that you should reasonably expect RJC to process and use your data to contact you regarding any enquiry you have made in relation to RJC' business services.

RJC does not knowingly collect, process or share personal information from people under the age of 18, nor does it collect sensitive information e.g. information on race, religion, political beliefs as it is not pertinent to its business services.

You are under no obligation to share data with RJC in making an enquiry, however RJC will be unable to answer your enquiry should you decide this.

How we use your data

Your data will only ever be used in conjunction with the business services of BCTS. Your data will be securely stored on the RJC database and used to contact you regarding your enquiry, or ongoing business with RJC.
